Heyaru Engineering from India wants to turn Lommel site into the largest diamond maker in Europe

The first diamond factory in Belgium comes in Lommel

The Indian company Heyaru Engineering is investing 26 million euros in a first phase in a company that will make synthetic diamonds in Lommel. Flanders supports the investment with 2 million euros. This was announced by Flemish Minister for Economy Philippe Muyters (N-VA) this weekend. Heyaru has the ambition to expand its site in the Lommel Crystal Park in the next five to ten years into the largest 'diamond factory' in Europe. An investment of 262 million euros, good for 120 to 150 employees in the long term.
