



## **'Diamond Valley' in Lommel: Heyaru will pump 260 million euros into Europe's largest diamond factory**

In June 2020 (**LOMMEL**), the first diamond was created at the Indian company Heyaru in Lommel. They can be used for jewelry, but just as well in the technology sector. The ambitions in North Limburg are enormous. “We want to become the largest and most modern diamond producer in Europe here and will invest approximately 260 million euros,” says founder Vikram Shah.

Heyaru is active in the so-called STEAM sector and thus focuses on science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics. “In fact, we mimic a little bit of Mother Nature,” smiles Vikram. “The problem is that in nature only two percent of diamonds are so-called 2A diamonds. By perfecting our science, we all make diamonds of this kind. So you can say that our diamonds are even better than in nature. ”
